



Ordinals

When we use numbers to compare, we often want more information than just "First," "Next," and "Last."

When we use numbers to tell an object's place in line, we often add letters to the end of a number. Practice saying the following:

First	-	1st	-	1		Sixth	-	6th	-	6
Second	-	2nd	-	2		Seventh	-	7th	-	7
Third	-	3rd	-	3		Eighth	-	8th	-	8
Fourth	-	4th	-	4		Ninth	-	9th	-	9
Fifth	-	5th	-	5		Tenth	-	10th	-	10

You can see that we have special words for first, second, and third. But all the others are just the number plus "th."

These chickens are in line for treats. Practice saying their position in line: Which one is first? Which is second? And so on.
